Initiatives and Workshops Initiated & Organised

- **“Philosophy for the Public” Workshop** — Initiated to spread philosophy among the general public in Egypt, in collaboration with the Philosophy Club, AUC (Spring 2017)
- **Bel Arabi Falsafa (Philosophy in Arabic)** — Initiated in August 2017 in collaboration with the Philosophy Club at The American University in Cairo (AUC). This initiative actively spreads philosophy in Arabic among the public across Egypt. It has delivered public philosophy lectures for over eight years at AUC and at various regional universities across Upper and Lower Egypt (including Deraya University, Qena University, and Sohag University). It also structured a major public lecture in partnership with UNESCO at their regional office in Egypt. Attendance has consistently reached up to 350 participants per event depending on the venue, timing, and theme.
The initiative secured funding from the Andrew Mellon Foundation for three years and successfully operated for five additional years on an entirely volunteer basis before and after the grant window. Throughout the funded tenure, it generated multiple accessible Arabic translations of classical philosophical compositions, as well as an original public philosophy work authored by Yossra Hamouda designed to contextualise philosophical discourse within contemporary Egyptian life. The initiative hosts monthly lectures or seminars to encourage public contributions to philosophical production.
